This is a chance to preview these exciting plays and to join in postshow discussions afterwards with a panel including the translators: leading Scottish playwright Linda McLean (strangers, babies & Shimmer) Christopher Campbell (Literary Manager of the National Theatre, London) and Lucien and Micheline Attoun, the Artistic Directors of Théâtre Ouvert.
